André Veyrac is a breeder at the Blanquies breeding centre, in the district of Sénergues, in Aveyron. Aged 53, he set up his business in 1983 and immediately set up an Aubrac breeding centre, where he currently has 150 mother cows and devotes himself to breeding and development activities.

His passion for breeding led him to acquire a second breeding centre in the centre of France, another breeding region, where he has built a herd of 90 Aubrac cows.

In addition to his work as a breeder, he has also set up a fattening workshop to enhance his herd's production. Secretary of the Aubrac Herd-Book, he regularly takes part in competitions as a breeder, but has also served on the jury, in the breed's original region, of SIMA in Paris and during the Aubrac Open 2007.
