



Bernard Crueize (France)

Breed: Aubrac, Open Show - 26 February

Bernard Crueize, born on 24 September 1954, established himself as a breeder in 1977 in Maschastel, in Lozère, in the canton of Nasbinals.

His 60 head of Aubrac mother cows, crossed with Charolais, then pure bred, is recognised for its quality crossbreeds, but also for giving birth to champion bulls, both in Paris and the Concours National Aubrac in 2006 at St Flour.

Winner of a Sabot d'Or in 2006, the best sire award and best IVMAT at Cournon in 2008, owner of TYPHON, best ISEVR index, Bernard Crueize has been a judge for many years, including for the Concours National Aubrac.
