



## **Dick Bradley (Irlande)**

### **Breed: Salers, Open Show - Thursday 26 February**

Dick Bradley was born on a farm in Ireland specialising in cattle, sheep farming and cereals. He was awarded a degree in agricultural sciences from the University of Dublin, before working as an agricultural consultant with the Irish Agricultural and Food Development Authority (Teagasc) for over 20 years, specialising in the production of suckler beef cattle and herd development.

Several years ago, Dick became a private cattle consultant. He imports and exports high quality cattle, and provides advice to a certain number of Irish livestock farmers. Dick has paid regular visits to French farms and has taken part in competitions over a number of years. He has bought excellent animals from French breeders, including five winners in Paris. This cattle and their offspring have won awards in every major show in Ireland, including the national show and plowing championships.

One of these animals, ULENA, was bought at SIMAGENA 2005 and was recently named Salers champion at the BEEF EXPO IRELAND 2008. Dick Bradley has also developed his own farm in Ireland, where he specialises in the production of beef cattle.
